PROJECT TITLE: Issuance of South Hill Tower Telecommunication Lease and Right of Entry Permit to City and County of San Francisco

LOCATION: San Bruno Mountain State Park **COUNTY:** San Mateo

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Provide a telecommunication ground lease and Right of Entry permit to the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF) for the emergency management radio tower at the South Hill Site at San Bruno Mountain State Park. The telecommunication ground lease includes replacement of an existing 40-foot emergency management radio tower with a 60-foot tower. A right of entry permit will be issued for one geotechnical boring to 30 feet below the existing ground surface that will be done prior to tower construction.

All work conducted in association with this easement will comply with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code.


